Located in the heart of California's rich San Joaquin Valley, Hanford is 200 miles from the greater Los Angeles area to the south and the San Francisco-Sacramento area to the north. With Interstate 5 and California Highway 99 just a short distance from the heart of Hanford and the Kings County Fairgrounds it makes for easy travel to the 2020 State Convention.

Hanford is situated in the San Joaquin Valley midway between San Francisco, 215 miles to the north, and Los Angeles, 215 miles to the south. Located in the north central portion of the county, the city is 32 miles south of Fresno and just due west of Visalia on 198.
